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### Enjoy an Italian Appetizer

An antipasto salad from Luna's in Stuart is pretty enough to serve to guests. The garlic knots are a twist on traditional garlic bread.

Antipasto, anyone? You bet: this is nice enough for company. Luna's an Italian pizzeria and restaurant serves up little rolls of salami, ham and provolone, dotted with pepperoni. They're perched like blossoms among olives, onion rings and tomatoes that top a fresh mix of greens. A fresh Italian vinaigrette is sent along as dressing. But oh, those garlic knots! These rolls elevate garlic bread to ambrosia. (\$5.95, feeds two generously, Garlic knots: \$3 a dozen. Luna's is in downtown Stuart at 49 Flagler Avenue.)
